Fact: The car speed monitored by race officials was 65.6 Kph

Offense: Breach of F.C.S.R. art. 14.5 and App.H art. 2.3.1 (FIA ISC)

Decision: Fine of 150 euros (art. 12.4.1c FIA ISC), fine shall be paid within forty eight hours of their notification (art. 12.8.1 of FIA ISC)

Reason: Car speed exceeded 60 Km/h in pit-lane

According to art. 27.2 of F.C.S.R. this penalty is not susceptible to appeal
