Circuit races sanctioned by the AMF are conducted in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code including all applicable appendices, the AMF Circuit Regulations, the AMF Event Regulations, the AMF License Regulations, the respective Series Regulations with any amendments and supplements (Bulletins) approved by the AMF, the Supplementary Regulations of the event concerned with any amendments and supplements, as well as all other regulations of the FIA and the AMF, if applicable.

For series of other ASNs, their regulations as well as the invitations to tender of the respective series shall apply in addition. The AMF guidelines for the approval of a series or event in motor sport must also be taken into account.
